	Learned counsel appearing for the respondents			
	submitted that the order, in reference, was challenged			
	before the Hon'ble High Court in writ petition. The writ			
	petition was dismissed. Thereafter the respondents had			
	filed L.P.A. No. 157 of 2016. The said L.P.A. has also been			
	dismissed. Now the respondents intend to file Special			
	Leave Petition in the Hon'ble Supreme Court.			
	Learned counsel has submitted that there was no			
	willful non-compliance of the order but the same has			
	been challenged at the various stages in the law courts			
	and they were awaiting the final verdict of the Court.			
	Learned counsel for the respondents has
