26	28.02.2023	<p>Case called out.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the Respondent- Department of Energy, Government of Jharkhand submitted that the arguing counsel is indisposed as such he is unable to attend the hearing today.</p> <p>An affidavit has been filed by the Respondent in compliance of the order dated 14.02.2023 annexing letter No. 819 dated 26.04.2022 issued by Respondent - Department of Government of Energy, Government of Jharkhand.</p> <p>On perusal of the letter it appears that the State Government was willing to let DVC take over the supply of electricity to all the consumers i.e. domestic, non-domestic, agriculture, LTIS etc. In pursuance, thereof, a direction was given for formation of joint team of senior officials of DVC and JBVNL to study the viability and for formulating the modalities</p>	

for such transfer of supply of electricity to the consumers.

It would be evident that nearly ten months have elapsed since issuance of the direction contained in the aforesaid letter but till date no status report regarding progress made by the joint Committee has been brought on record.

Learned counsel for the Respondent-Department of Energy, Government of Jharkhand shall file a detailed affidavit bringing on record the progress made in the light of the direction given in the aforesaid letter and the plea that NOC cannot be given in view of the aforesaid letter. The Respondent shall also file reply to the statement of the Petitioner that in terms of the provisions of section 43 of Electricity Act, 2003, NOC is not required by DVC for supplying electricity to the consumers beyond its command area.
