## **PUBLIC NOTICE**

**Suggestions/Comments invited from various stakeholders on the proposed JSERC (Renewable Purchase Obligation and its Compliance) Regulations, 2020, by the Commission.**

The Commission had notified the JSERC (RPO and its Compliance) Regulations, 2016, in December, 2016, for stipulating the Renewable Energy Purchase Obligation for the Obligated Entities within the State of Jharkhand, since the period of earlier Regulations issued viz., Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Energy Purchase Obligation and its compliance) Regulations, 2010 and Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission (Renewable Energy Purchase Obligation and its compliance) Regulations, 2016, expired in March 2020 and in light of the Letter No. 30/04/2018-R&R issued by the Ministry of Power on February 1, 2019, and in order to fix a minimum percentage of total consumption of the electricity of the Obligated Entities for purchase of energy from Renewable Energy Sources and to achieve long term growth trajectory of Renewable Purchase Obligation (RPO) from Solar as well as Non-Solar Energy, the Commission is notifying this Draft JSERC (RPO and its Compliance) Regulations, 2020.
