5. 28.9.2010. Mr. M.S. Mittal, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioners submitted that these writ petitions challenging the bills of demand charges on 75% of the contract demand are now fully covered by the judgment of this Court dated 17.09.2010 passed in M/s. Laxmi Business & Cement Co. (P) Ltd., -W.P. (C) Nos. 2613 of 2010 with analogous case.
