It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that pursuant to the order dated 16.04.2012, the parties have settled their disputes outside the court. The said contention has also been supported by an affidavit sworn by the contesting respondent no. 3. It has been stated in the affidavit that a meeting was arranged on 22.11.2013 in the office of the Principal Secretary, Department of Home, Government of Jharkhand, in which all the concerned parties took part and after due deliberation, they arrived at settlement in the following terms:-

- (i) Sainik Kalyan Nideshalaya will look into all the complaints received from the Commission and discharge its obligation in terms of the conditions stated in the allotment letter No-SKN/22/AB/SF/03/150, dated 23rd June, 2003. Compliance in this regard will be communicated to the Commission in writing with a copy to the Department of Home, Government of Jharkhand, Ranchi.
- JSERC will also promptly verify and pay all the legitimate dues to Sainik Kalyan Nideshalaya and will strictly discharge its obligation as per the terms and conditions of the allotment letter.
- (iii) Since the amounts of the rental and other charges received from the premises of Dr.Rajendra Prasad Jawan Bhawan-cum-Sainik Bazar complex are used for carrying out welfare activities for the ex-servicemen, war widows and their dependents, realisation of rental charges on time is imperative for smooth functioning of Sainik Kalyan Nideshalaya.

Learned counsel submitted that this writ petition may be

disposed of in the terms above mentioned.

Learned counsel for respondent no. 3 has accepted the same and stated that as per the terms of settlement, they shall withdraw B.G.P. Eviction Case No. 01 of 2010, pending in the court of Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sadar, Ranchi.

In view of the above, this writ petition is disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
