The Commission feels that the petition of the petitioner-ECL is premature. They first have to approach the National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) to find out whether they have the power available as demanded by the petitioner-ECL and thereafter approach the State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC) and Regional Load Despatch Centre (RLDC) to find out whether the network has the capacity to transmit the power from NTPC's generating station to the premises of petitioner-ECL. Once this is done, then the Commission will be in a position to consider the petition, in question.

The petition of the petitioner-ECL is disposed of accordingly.
