1.	10.03.2011	<p>As per Clause 17 of JSERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2005 every distribution licensees including the deemed licensee are required to file the Schedule of Charges along with every application for determination of tariff under Section 64 of the Electricity Act 2003 and the Commission, after examining the schedule of charges filed by the licensee and after considering the views of all interested parties, issue an order granting its approval thereon with such modifications, alterations or such conditions as may be specified in that order. From the tariff petitions being filed by the licensees it is seen that none of the licensees are filing the schedule of charges for approval of the Commission. During the public hearings also the issue of different licensees having different schedule of charges was also raised.</p> <p>The Commission feels that in order to have the uniformity in the schedule of charges of the licensees and also to comply with the provisions of the Supply Code Regulations, it is necessary that the licensees should file schedule of charges along with the tariff petitions for approval of the Commission.</p>	

In view of the above, this case is being registered suo-motu and all the licensee of the State are directed to file schedule of charges along with their ARR and tariff petition for determination of tariffs for FY 2011-12 by 31st March 2011. The licensees, who have already filed their ARR and tariff petitions for FY 2011-12, should file the schedule of charges separately by 31st March 2011 for approval of the Commission.

Issue notice to all the licensees of the State to comply with the aforesaid order.
