	the licensees and generating companies and to refer any dispute		
	for arbitration:"		
	As per the above, the Commission is having jurisdiction		
	to adjudicate the disputes between the licensees and generating		

companies only. This is a case of dispute regarding release of new service connection in the premises of the petitioner and it is a dispute between the consumer and the licensee. Hence as per Section 86(1)(f) of Indian Electricity Act, 2003, adjudication of the petitioner's case will not come under the jurisdiction of the Commission.

In view of the above, the petitioner is directed to approach Consumer Grievances Redressal Forum, Ranchi and sought for adjudication.

With this the case is disposed off at no cost.
