they have received a cheque of Rs. 23, 32, 000/- (Rupees twenty three lacs thirty two thousand) but submitted that the amount was not correctly calculated and some more amount is payable by the respondents.

The respondents, by way of reply, have denied the same and have explained the calculation of the amount. It has been submitted that amount has been correctly calculated and has been duly paid to the petitioner.

In view of the payment of the amount, after calculating the same, as explained in the affidavit filed by the respondents, we find substantial compliance of the order of the Commission.

No further proceeding/ order is, thus, required in the case.

The case is, accordingly, disposed of.
