03	08.08.2018	<p>Heard.</p> <p>The Commission had issued the Tariff order for the distribution and retail supply business of Damodar Valley Corporation (DVC) in the area falling within the territory of Jharkhand vide their order dated 18.05.2018. The order provides certain voltage rebates and load factor rebates. Along with its petition, the petitioner has enclosed bills issued by the DVC to M/s Shivam Iron and Steel Company Ltd. in which the petitioner claims that the rebate admissible to the M/s Shivam Iron and Steel Company Ltd. has not been granted.</p> <p>The petition has been filed by Association of DVC HT Consumers and has been signed by Mr.</p>	

Pramod Kumar Agarwala as Joint Secretary of the Association. Mr. Agarwala is also the Director of M/s Shivam Iron and Steel Company Ltd.

The petition has been filed as seeking clarifications in tariff order. However, on close reading of the tariff order and submissions made by the petitioner, it is evident that order of the Commission relating to rebates is clearly drafted, and there is no any such ambiguity. By way of filing petition for clarifications, the petitioner wants to expand the scope of the rebate and also get the individual dispute of tariff addressed by the Commission. Billing dispute is rightfully the subject of Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum (CGRF) and hence the petition is not maintainable here.

Accordingly, the case is disposed off.
