The petition has been filed as seeking clarifications in tariff order. However, on close reading of the tariff order and submissions made by the petitioner, it is evident that order of the Commission relating to rebates is clearly drafted, and there is no any such ambiguity. By way of filing petition for clarifications, the petitioner wants to expand the scope of the rebate and also get the individual dispute of tariff addressed by the Commission. Billing dispute is rightfully the subject of Consumer Grievance Redressal Forum (CGRF) and hence the petition is not maintainable here.

Accordingly, the case is disposed off.
