Review of the decisions, directions and orders (1) The Commission may at any time, on its own motion, or on an application of any of the person(s) or parties concerned, within 30 days of making such decision, directions or order, review such decision, directions or orders and pass such appropriate orders as the Commission deem fit;</p> <p style="text-align: justify;">Provided that power to review by the Commission on its own motion under this clause may be exercised only for correction of arithmetical mistakes arising from any accidental slip or omission."</p> <p style="text-align: justify;">The Commission is likely to issue a fresh tariff order within the next one month.
