		called for clarification regarding utilization of power	
		generated from Unit Nos. I & IV of Tata Power	
		Corporation Limited (TPCL) at Jojobera. But even after	
		lapse of three weeks no clarification was received from	
		TPCL. As such, the Commission by its letter dated	
		31.12.2010 had issued reminder to send the	
		information/clarification called for about the Unit-I and	
		IV of TPCL at Jojobera Power Plant within a week. The	
		said letter was sent by Fax as well as by post on the	
		same day. Though more than three weeks have elapsed,	
		no clarification/information called for has been received	
		till date. Hence the Commission initiates this proceeding	
		and directs the TPCL to furnish the following	
		information:	
		1. The year of commissioning of Units I & IV and the	
		details of energy generated in M.U., PLF etc.	
		2. As the TPCL is a power generating company, has there	
		been any Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) entered into	
		for the energy generated by Units I & IV?	
		3. If so, furnish a copy of the PPA with respect to Units I	
		& IV.	

- 4. If these two units are treated as Captive Power Plants (CPP), do these satisfy the conditions of CPP as per the Electricity Act, 2003?
- 5. If these two units satisfy the conditions of CPP as per the Act, then, where the generated power of Units I & IV is utilized and to what extent?
- 6. A detailed network diagram showing the details of feeding from Units I & IV to the 132 KV bus system and from 132 KV bus system to the connected load be furnished.
- 7. Also the detailed network diagram pertaining to all the four generating units be furnished.

The above information must be furnished to the Commission by 15th February 2011.
