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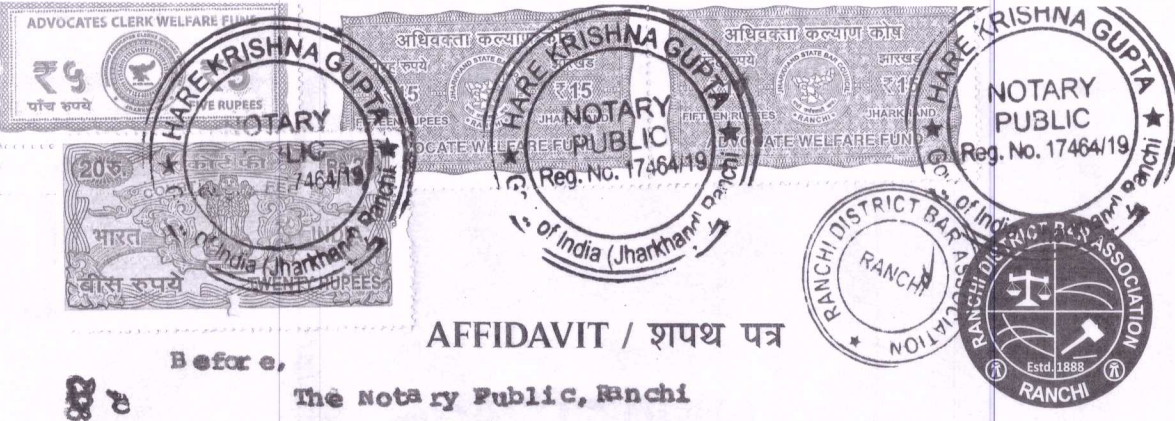

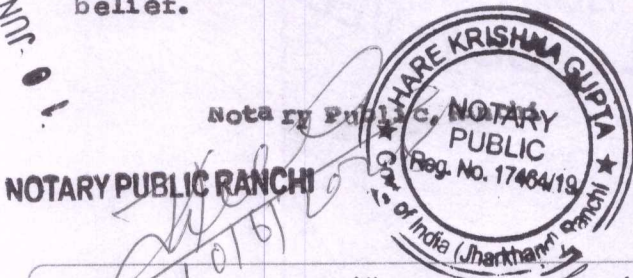

Review of Hon'ble Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission's Order dated 30.04.2025, (hereinafter referred as 'Order') on Provisional True-Up for FY 2023-24, APR for FY 2024-25 and ARR and SLDC Charges for FY 2025-26 for State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC) under Section 94 of the Electricity Act 2003 and the JSERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2024 and other enabling provisions.

AND

IN THE MATTER OF:

State Load Despatch Centre (hereinafter referred to as "SLDC" which shall mean for the purpose of this petition the Licensee), having its registered office at Kusai Colony, Doranda, Ranchi.

Petitioner

The Petitioner respectfully submits as under:

1. Jharkhand Urja Sancharan Nigam Ltd. (herein after to be referred to as "JUSNL" or "the Petitioner" has been incorporated on 23rd October 2013 with the Registrar of Companies, Jharkhand, Ranchi and has obtained Certificate of Commencement of Business on 28th November 2013. The Petitioner is a Company constituted under the provisions of Government of Jharkhand, General Resolution as notified by transfer scheme vide notification no. 8, dated 6th January 2014.
2. The State Load Despatch Centre is a Centre established by the State Government to be operated by a Government company or any Authority or Corporation established or constituted by or under the State Act, as may be notified by the State Government.
3. Section 31 of the Electricity Act, 2003, provides for constitution of State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC). The section 31 of Electricity Act, 2003 is reproduced below:



"31. (1) The State Government shall establish a Centre to be known as the State Load Despatch Centre for the purposes of exercising the powers and discharging the functions under this Part.

(2) The State Load Despatch Centre shall be operated by a Government company or any authority or corporation established or constituted by or under any State Act, as may be notified by the State Government.

Provided that until a Government company or any authority or corporation is notified by the State Government, the State Transmission Utility shall operate the State Load Despatch Centre:

Provided further that no State Load Despatch Centre shall engage in the business of trading in electricity."

4. As no Separate entity either in the form of Government company or authority or corporation has been notified by the State Government, the State Transmission Utility namely Jharkhand Urja Snacharan Nigam Limited (JUSNL) is operating the State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC).
5. SLDC had filed a Petition before the Hon'ble Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission for approval of the Provisional True-Up for the FY 2023-24, Annual performance Review for FY 2024-25 and ARR and SLDC Charges for FY 2025-26 as per the Electricity Act, 2003 and as per the provisions of the JSERC (Levy and Collection of Fees and Charges by State Load Despatch Centre) Regulations, 2020.
6. Hon'ble Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission on 30.04.2025 has issued its Order on SLDC's Petition for approval of Provisional True-Up for the FY 2023-24, Annual Performance Review for FY 2024-25 and ARR and SLDC Charges for FY 2025-26.
7. The Petitioner has analysed the Order given by the Hon'ble Commission and based on our understanding, the Petitioner believes that certain aspect in the Order are not in line with the intent of the Regulations and ought to be reviewed.
8. By means of this Petition, the Petitioner is submitting its observations on the aforesaid points which need to be reviewed in line with the provisions of the Regulations and prudent industry practices. The submissions are provided in the following paragraphs.



Power of the Hon'ble Commission to Review its decisions

9. The Petitioner submits that Regulation 41.1 of JSERC (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2024 provides the power to this Hon'ble Commission to review its orders. The relevant excerpts of the regulations are reproduced below for reference:

"41. REVIEW OF THE DECISIONS, DIRECTIONS AND ORDERS

41.1 Any Person aggrieved by the direction, decision, or order of the Commission, from which (i) no appeal has been preferred of (ii) from which no appeal is allowed, may, upon the discovery of new and important matter or evidence which, after exercise of due diligence, was not within his knowledge or could not be produced by him at that time when the direction, decision or order was passed or on account of some mistake or error apparent from the face of the record, or for any other sufficient reasons, may apply for review of such order, within thirty (30) days of the date of the direction, decision or order, as the case may be, to the Commission."

10. Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission's (Conduct of Business) Regulations, 2024 provide for a time period of 30 days from the Order within which State Load Despatch Centre (SLDC) can file for the Review Petition against the Order.

Facts of the Case

I. Determination of SLDC Charges for FY 2025-26

11. The petitioner submits that it has requested Hon'ble Commission to determine the SLDC Charges as per the clause A 11 of the JSERC (Levy of Collection of Fees and Charges by State Load Despatch Centre) Regulations, 2020 which states as follows:

"11.1 The SLDC Fees and Charges shall comprise State Load Despatch Centre Fees to be recoverable by SLDC towards registration for commencement of grid access and scheduling and annual charges to be collected in the form of Annual LDC Charges from users.

11.2 The Annual SLDC Charges shall correspond to the expenditure proposed to be incurred by the SLDC and as approved by the Commission. The Annual LDC Charges (ALC) as approved by the Commission shall be recovered on monthly basis.

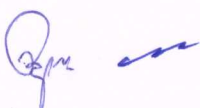
11.3 The Monthly SLDC Charges shall be collected from the users as per the norms given below:

Monthly LDC Charges=Annual LDC Charges/12/ (Total Contracted Capacity)

Where,

Monthly LDC Charges is in Rs./MW/month

Annual LDC Charges is in Rs. (as approved by the Commission)



Total Contracted Capacity is the sum of the Average Transmission Capacity Contracted by the users during the month (in MW)."

12. Further, the Contracted Capacity of the system was determined by considering the total power purchase capacity allocated to all the beneficiaries of SLDC in the state of Jharkhand. The list of all beneficiaries along with their contracted capacities was enclosed along with the petition. The same is enclosed along with this petition as **Annexure I**. The total contracted capacity of the system is 3491.73 MW.
13. Based upon the projected capacity of the transmission system, the Monthly SLDC Charges had been determined as follows:

Tariff Determination	FY 2025-26
Aggregate revenue requirement (Rs. Crore)	27.24
Contracted Capacity (MW)	3491.73
Annual LDC Charges (Rs./MW/Month)	6501.44

14. The SLDC will bill these charges on monthly basis to the beneficiaries as per their contracted capacity.
15. However, Hon'ble Commission in its order has approved the SLDC Charges as follows:

"The Commission accordingly approves SLDC charges of Rs 0.01/kWh in line with transmission tariff for JUSNL, which shall be applicable from May 1st, 2025 and shall remain applicable till amended or modified or extended by an order of this Commission."

16. The Petitioner would like to submit that the Hon'ble Commission has approved the SLDC Charges on a per unit basis whereas the Petitioner had requested to approve the same on a Rs./MW/Month basis. Also, the Hon'ble Commission while approving the SLDC Charges has not provided the methodology of levying the charges to the beneficiaries of the Petitioner and the list of beneficiaries has also not been approved.
17. The Petitioner would like to request the Hon'ble Commission to amend the SLDC Charges approved vide. the Tariff Order issued on 30.04.2025 and approve the SLDC Charges on a Rs./MW/Month as per the submission made by the



Petitioner in the Tariff Petition. The Petitioner would also like to request the Hon'ble Commission to approve the list of beneficiaries to whom the SLDC Charges have to be levied.

Prayers before the Hon'ble Commission:

The Petitioner respectfully prays before the Hon'ble Commission may:

- a) Admit this Review Petition for Review of the Hon'ble Commission's Order on the Petitioner's Provisional True Up Petition for FY 2023-24, APR for FY 2024-25 and ARR and SLDC Charges for FY 2025-26.
- b) Grant an expeditious hearing of this Review Petition.
- c) Approve SLDC Charges as submitted by the Petitioner in the Tariff Petition on a Rs./MW/Month basis.
- d) Approve the list of beneficiaries to whom the SLDC Charges shall be billed by the Petitioner.
- e) Issue appropriate directives if any.
- f) Condone any inadvertent omissions/ errors/ rounding off differences/ shortcomings/ deficiencies in this Review Petition and permit the Petitioner to add/ modify / alter this filing and make further submissions as may be required at a future date.
- g) Pass such further and other Orders, as the Hon'ble Commission may deem fit and appropriate, keeping in view of the facts and circumstances of the Case.
