**CORRIGENDUM**

**Corrigendum to the Order on Annual Performance Review for FY 2016-17 and Determination of Revised ARR and Tariff for the FY 2017-18 & FY 2018-19 for Jharkhand Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited (JBVNL) issued by the Commission on 27.04.2018 in Case (T) No: 13 of 2017.**

It has come to the notice of the Commission that there is a typographical correction in the Chapter A13: Terms and Conditions of Supply of the above-mentioned Order. The Corrigendum to rectify the same is accordingly issued as under:

1. Clause IV of Chapter A13: Terms and Conditions of Supply (Delayed Payment Surcharge) shall be read as under:

“The delayed payment surcharge will be at the rate of 1.5% per month and part thereof. **The due date for making payment of energy bills or other charges shall be as stipulated in the JSERC (Supply Code) Regulations, 2015 and its amendments which is presently minimum 15 days after issue date of bill for LT Domestic, Commercial and Agriculture category and minimum 21 days after issue date of bill for other categories.** The bill should be generated and delivered on monthly basis. In case, the licensee defaults in generating and delivering bills on monthly basis, DPS will not be charged for the period of default by licensee.

2. Clause IX of Chapter A13: Terms and Conditions of Supply (Rebate for prompt payment) shall be read as under:

“**The due date for making payment of energy bills or other charges shall be as stipulated in the JSERC (Supply Code) Regulations, 2015 and its amendments which is presently minimum 15 days after issue date of bill for LT Domestic, Commercial and Agriculture category and minimum 21 days after issue date of bill for other categories.** Rebate of 0.5% on the billed amount for timely payment of the bills for all the category of consumers shall be allowed”

3. Clause X of Chapter A13: Terms and Conditions of Supply (Rebate for online payment) shall be read as under:

“To motivate the consumers to make online payment of the bills through online web portal or digital methods, **a rebate of 1% of the billed amount (subject to maximum of Rs 250) shall be allowed. This rebate shall be in addition to rebate @ 0.5% for prompt payment.** However, online payment rebate shall be applicable if the consumer makes full payment of the bill within due date.”
