

# **Jharkhand State Electricity Regulatory Commission**

## **CORRIGENDUM**

**Corrigendum to the Order dated November 24, 2022 on Business Plan and MYT Petition for the Control Period from FY 2021-22 to FY 2025-26 and Tariff determination for FY 2021-22 for Tata Steel Limited issued by the Commission in Case (Tariff) no. 13 of 2020.**

- 1) The Commission observes that there has been an inadvertent error in the Section A 13 Terms and Conditions of Supply Clause VIII paragraph 3 specified for Prompt Payment Rebate and Rebate for Online Payment in Pg. 119 of the Tariff Order dated November 24, 2022 as reproduced below:

**“Clause VIII: Prompt Payment Rebate and Rebate for Online Payment**

The due date for making payment of energy bills or other charges shall be as specified in Clauses 10.1.5 of the JSERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2015, as amended from time to time.

Prompt Payment Rebate shall be allowed for payment of bills by the Consumers in accordance with Clauses 10.76 of the JSERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Distribution Tariff) Regulations, 2020, as amended from time to time.

Further, a rebate of 1.00% shall be allowed on the billed amount for payment within the due date of the entire billed amount made either through online or any digital mode **or through cash** subject to a maximum ceiling rebate of Rs. 250 against the billed amount.

Further no rebate shall be allowed after due date irrespective of the mode of payment.”

**The phrase “or through cash” stands deleted now from the above clause.**

- 2) Accordingly, Clause VIII of Terms and Conditions of Supply of the Tariff order shall be read as follows:

**“Clause VIII: Prompt Payment Rebate and Rebate for Online Payment**

The due date for making payment of energy bills or other charges shall be as specified in Clause 10.1.5 of the JSERC (Electricity Supply Code) Regulations, 2015, as amended from time to time.




Prompt Payment Rebate shall be allowed for payment of bills by the Consumers in accordance with Clause 10.76 of the JSERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Distribution Tariff) Regulations, 2020, as amended from time to time.

Further, a rebate of 1.00% shall be allowed on the billed amount for payment within the due date of the entire billed amount made either through online or any digital mode subject to a maximum ceiling rebate of Rs. 250 against the billed amount.

Further no rebate shall be allowed after due date irrespective of the mode of payment.”
